Recommended Hardwood Trees for Casa del Lago

In Lee County, a tree is considered to be a living, woody, self-supporting plant, ten feet or more in height, having one or more well-defined main stems or trunks four inches or more in diameter at breast height. Palms are not classified as trees. Additional types of trees may be approved by the Architectural Review Board.

Any removal or addition of a tree must be submitted to the ARB for approval prior to any removal or planting.

We recommend the following trees which are suitable for our smaller sized property lots:

Bottlebrush
Clusia (N)
Dahoon Holly (N)
East Palatka Holly (N)
Madagascar Olive
Magnolia, Little Gem
Red Maple (N)
Simpson's Stopper (N)
Spanish Stopper (N)
Spiny Black Olive Tree
